# ORTHOPAEDIC UPDATE - KNEES

Knees for GPs: Masquerades, red flags and pearls for the probable diagnoses

#### OVERVIEW:

This webinar will be an interactive, case-based presentation regarding knee conditions seen in general practice. Using the 'Murtagh diagnostic model', the aim is to highlight the thought processes in making a diagnosis from the perspective of an orthopaedic knee surgeon. It will also review the indications for advanced imaging, highlight non-operative optimisation strategies and discuss when referral to a specialist is indicated.

#### LEARNING OUTCOMES:

1. Identify key elements in history and physical examination when developing a diagnosis for a knee condition
2. Recommend when to refer for advanced imaging and seek a specialist opinion
3. Recognise that hip and thigh problems can masquerade as a primary knee problem
