Management of high-risk pregnancy inclusive of such conditions as pre-eclampsia, post-datism, third trimester bleeding, intra-uterine growth retardation, premature rupture of membranes, premature labour and multiple gestation	Tier A
Management of patients with/without medical, surgical or obstetrical complications for normal labour, including mild toxemia, threatened abortion, normal puerperal patient, normal antepartum and postpartum care, postpartum complications and foetal demise	Tier A
Management of pregnant patients with medical conditions and / or medical complications of pregnancy, including pregnancy induced hypertension, chronic hypertension, diabetes mellitus, renal disease, coagulopathies, cardiac disease, anaemias and haemoglobinopathies, thyroid disease, sexually transmitted disease, pulmonary disease, thromboembolic disorders, infectious disease, ectopic pregnancy and other accidents of pregnancy such as incomplete, complete, or missed abortion	Tier A
Manual removal of placenta	Tier A
Obstetrical ultrasound	Tier A
Pudendal and paracervical blocks	Tier A
Repair of fourth degree perineal lacerations or of cervical laceration	Tier A
Use of vacuum extractor for delivery	Tier A
