Grant Overview

Guest speaker grants are available to support Teams, Departments and VMO's to fund experts in their field to come to Epworth and share their expertise on a particular topic that will educate and inspire our workforce. Topics are expected to encourage staff to review the way we currently deliver services and engage diverse groups. Presentations by the guest speaker may be virtual or in person. Approximately 2 grants will be awarded each year for up to \$20,000.

Eligibility Criteria

Any individual or group within Epworth, who meets the following criteria can apply for a Guest Speaker Grant.

Employees	VMOs
Employed in a permanent ongoing role or have a minimum of 2 years remaining on contract	Minimum appointment of 12 months
Minimum length of service of 12 months as at application closing date	Primary private practice at Epworth
No performance management or attendance management concerns at the time of application	No practice restrictions, disclosures or breaches of the By-laws in the past 12 months

Application Process

- > Each application must have a nominated Project Lead.
- > The Project Lead will be responsible to manage the application process and grant management.
- > Additional Project Members can be added in the application form.
- > The Project Lead will be asked to represent the group in the selection process.





Selection Panel

The selection panel are responsible for the shortlisting and interview process.

The panel is made up of the **Executive Director** Epworth Medical Foundation & Brand, **Chief Operating Officer** Hospitals (or delegate) and **Executive Director** People & Culture.



Application Requirements

Project Lead will must complete and submit the application form. The application form will require:

Multi-disciplinary and/or multi-speciality and/or multi-site collaboration Project seeks to provide opportunities across the Epworth group	15%
Experience in Project/Program Management Demonstrated ability to manage execution of grant	10%
